Winemaking

A portion of the grapes are gently pressed and statically purified and subsequently fermented at a controlled temperature of roughly 20 °C in steel tanks. Almost 15 percent of the wine is fermented in barriques made from French Allier oak with subsequent biological acid degradation. Assembly is then carried out the following spring.

Our tasting note

The Pinot Grigio Castel Ringberg glows a bright and intense straw yellow. Complex aromas of fruits, particularly ripe pears, a hint of sage and lime blossoms characterise the spicy bouquet. Elegance and harmony dominate on the palate, combined with creamy fullness.
